- 22 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) express thanks to everyone who has faithfully supported the Lord's work among the O'odham people. They have been encouraged by the financial support, visits, phone calls, emails, and most of all prayers.
- 23 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they seek to balance the work of benevolence with the work of the gospel. The needs of the poor are great, but there is a point at which helping in this area can be more harmful to gospel work than helpful.
- 24 The Torreses (Juarez, MX) thank God that they have had a considerable number of visits in the last month. They ask that we pray for conversions and that these people find in their church a place to be discipled.
- 25 USAF Chaplain S. asks prayer for our Air Force deployers. Many will be rotating home and many coming in to replace them. Pray that the Lord would grant a blessed reunion for those finishing and a fruitful deployment for those coming in.
- 26 Pastor S.B. asks us to pray for the broader church in India. There are thousands of churches, pastors, ministers, and believers there. However, most of the people and pastors are corrupt. The pastors are not preaching Biblical doctrine, and they are leading the people into corruption. Many pastors are taking the glory of God for themselves, and they become an idol in the churches. Pray for revival in the church and for the pastors and believers to repent.

- 31 The Baldwin's request prayer for the growing need of more space for BTS, Nov Sad, Serbia, especially the need for more dorm and classroom space as they move into developing a Master's program alongside the Bachelors' program. A 4-story building with kitchen, classrooms and dorms would be at least 500,000 euros. A new building would cost twice that. There is no way to expand their present building any more than they currently are doing. Pray for the Lord's direction.

- 1 The Favres ask prayer for the many challenges they face in France this year, in particular a presidential election which will be important for the religious and moral transformation of the country.
- 2 Please continue to pray for Baruch Maoz this month as he ministers in Israel preaching, advising pastors, and visiting congregants and unbelieving friends. Also, pray for his work on study notes for the book of Job the last of his Old Testament projects before turning to the New Testament.
- 3 Please pray for Trevor Johnson. Recently he has had a relapse of severe chronic pain from past illness from malaria caught on the field. He has had to cancel church visits that were scheduled with the intent of sharing the work in Papua. He also asks prayer for the renovating of a newly purchased building to house more students in the jungle. Many children are now being schooled for the first time ever.
- 4 Please pray for David Vaughn's (France) recovery. In November a stent was placed in his left coronary artery (LCA) which was more than 80% blocked. It was also discovered that he has a case of pericarditis (inflammation of the tissue surrounding the heart), for which he is under treatment. Pray for the church's pastoral needs to be well provided for during the next few weeks of David's convalescence.
- 5 Pray for the Secrests' anticipated medical mission outreach to Riobamba, Ecuador (January 8–15). They have a team of 8 Peruvians who will meet with 11 from the USA (Volunteers in Medical Missions) to serve among the Quichuas in the mountains of Ecuador.

It is a rough and poor area, but the folks they are connecting with are sweet, appreciative, and are showing interest in the possibility of a Bible study.
- 14 Pray for the Masters (Argentina) as they have mission outreach projects scheduled in 2022, as well as a pastor's retreat in March 2022.

- 15 The Wengers report that some are contemplating baptism in Neuchâtel's church. Please pray that the Spirit of God would work in their hearts so that they will be convinced of the necessity and that they can begin the preparation for baptism.
- 16 Pr. Obed Rupertus (Santiago, Chile) requests our prayers that the Lord would bind together the hearts of this congregation that's merging "older" members with newly-baptized and recently-joined members. They rejoice to have outgrown the once-monthly rental they'd been using during Covid. Please ask the Lord to provide a place where they can gather for worship.
- 17 Please persevere in prayer for healing for Pr. Jorge Molina (Carlos Paz, ARG), whose right leg has two very painful ulcers that are resisting treatment. Also, continue to pray that God will send someone to help in pastoring the small, but faithful congregation in Carlos Paz, ARG.
