- 2 Please pray for Denise Favre (France) as she finishes her preparation for the 4 Bible lessons that will be taught to children—ages 4 to 7 years old—at the family camp in France this month.
- 3 Please pray for USAF Chaplain S's family as they are leaving San Antonio and moving to FL. They will be traveling for a few weeks. Pray for safety in their travels.
- 4 Pray for First Baptist Church of Lisbon and the pastoral transition. Pray for faithfulness and wisdom as Tiago Oliveira seeks to lead this church.
- 5 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) report that Archie Hendricks Nursing Facility is being very cautious again as there have been new COVID cases on the reservation. They praise God that the facility is allowing 2 people in the facility each week, as long as they have a negative rapid test prior to entering. Please pray for this ministry.
- 6 The Masters (Argentina) ask prayer for the Simeon Trust seminar July 7–9. Please pray that God will bless this time.
