Also, pray for the teachers including two pastors from HBC, Owensboro, KY, Mark Redfern and Thad Gunderson.
- 2 The Kilians ask prayer for new faculty joining African Christian University. They need to be unified in mission and teaching approach.
- 3 Pastor Obed Rupertus (Santiago, CHE) requests urgent prayer for their nation, scheduled for a Sept. 4 vote on adopting a new constitution drafted and driven by the Communist/Socialist party. Pray that our brothers and sisters there continue to have liberty to worship and serve God. In addition, pray that as they grow in grace they will also grow in understanding of how their faith in God affects the principles of how they vote in national affairs.
