Countries to Pray For:

Guinea (AFRICA)

Population: 15,220,392

Languages: French, local languages

Religions: Sunni Muslim; Roman Catholic, Baptist; indigenous beliefs

People: Repressive socialist rule caused economic ruin. Abundant natural resources; major exporter of agricultural products. One of the lowest literacy rates and highest rates of child marriage in the world. Ongoing practice of polygamy.

What to Pray About: Despite its natural resources, the people live in poverty. One of the least evangelized countries in Africa. The largest unreached people groups are the Fulani, Maninka, and Susu (all Muslim); Muslims and Christians tend to incorporate indigenous African beliefs. Thousands of deaths from Ebola (ongoing crisis); growing HIV/AIDS epidemic; malnutrition and malaria are serious problems. Great need for Gospel witness.

Guinea-Bissau (AFRICA)

Population: 2,291,896

Languages: Portuguese, Criolo, African languages

Religions: Sunni Muslim, Roman Catholic, indigenous beliefs

People: Guerrilla warfare and a bloody civil war severely damaged nation's infrastructure; ongoing political instability. Latin America- based drug traffickers use country as transshipment point to Europe for cocaine with little resistance from government.

What to Pray About: Freedom of religion; many Christian groups do humanitarian work, but majority do not stay long-term to evangelize and start churches. Government corruption; leaders involved in drug trafficking. Country of origin for child labor and sex trafficking, mostly young boys transported to Senegal; estimated 200 boys trafficked each month. Malaria a main cause of death; high maternal mortality. Great need for Gospel witness.
