Countries to Pray For:

Grenada (CARIBBEAN)

Population: 117,218

Languages: English, French patois

Religions: Roman Catholic, Anglican, Pentecostal, 7th Day Adventist

People: Leading producer of many spices; organic cocoa and farming. Large number of the younger population migrating away from islands. Located in the hurricane belt; widespread poverty an ongoing issue.

What to Pray About: High number identifies with Catholicism; small communities of Mormons and Mennonites in the islands. Steady decline in morality and family life, even in evangelical congregations. Widespread promiscuity and teen pregnancies; around 45% of households are led by women, with men often abroad in search of employment. Gospel witness – Pastor Godfrey Bain of Grace Reformed Baptist Church (Grenville).

Guatemala (CENTRAL AMERICA)

Population: 18,962,856

Languages: Spanish; 21 Mayan languages; Garifuna, Xinca

Religions: Roman Catholic, Pentecostal, Protestant

People: Significant natural disasters. More than half the population are Mayan. Significant number of Guatemalans live outside their country (1.5 million immigrants in the USA). One of the poorest countries in Latin America.

What to Pray About: Significant Mormon presence; highest proportion of Eastern Orthodox adherents in the Western Hemisphere. Traditional Mayan religion persists. Guatemala has among the worst health outcomes; some of the highest infant mortality rates; one of the lowest life expectancies at birth in the region; third highest femicide rate in the world. Killings and death squads have been common since the end of the civil war (1996). Gospel witness – Pastors Mark Mudge and Lee Russi of Iglesia Biblica Antorcha (Guatemala City).
