Countries to Pray For:

Iraq (MIDDLE EAST)

Population: 48,583,520

Languages: Arabic, Kurdish, Turkoman, Assyrian, Armenian

Religions: Mostly Shi'a Muslim; small percentage Sunni Muslim

People: Historically known as Mesopotamia; non-Muslims include Chaldeans, Assyrians, Syriacs, Armenians, Anglicans, and Protestants. Decades of conflict from divisive factions and insurgent groups has also hindered economic progress; increasing debate about splitting Iraq into three autonomous regions between Sunni, Shiite, and Kurdish factions.

What to Pray About: ISIS oppression has terrorized the country, attempting to “cleanse” the nation of all Christians and religious minorities; these groups have faced massive increase in persecution, kidnappings, property destruction, rape, and murder. Great need for Gospel witness.

Republic of Ireland (EUROPE)

Population: 5,267,158

Languages: English, Gaelic

Religions: Roman Catholic, Church of Ireland (Anglican)

People: Historic animosity and ongoing segregation between Catholic Irish and Protestant settlers. Northern Ireland remained a province of the UK after Republic of Ireland gained independence (1922). Rising numbers pursue witchcraft as return to Irish roots; strong resistance to religious oppression after Catholic church abuse scandals were exposed.

What to Pray About: Increasing secularism; resentment from historical conflicts hinder gospel witness. Gospel witness – Pastor Mark Fitzpatrick of Arann Reformed Baptist Church (Dublin); Pastors Stephen Murphy and Michael Emadi of Dundalk Baptist Church (Co Louth); Pastor Jonathan Burke of Donaghadee Baptist Church (Northern Ireland); Magherafelt Reformed Baptist Church (Northern Ireland); the Association of Baptist Churches in Ireland (ABC, ABCi, and ABCI).
