Countries to Pray For:

Australia (OCEANIA)

Population: 28,182,300

Languages: English

Religions: Christianity, Atheism, Buddhism, Muslim

People: One of the most ethnically-diverse nations; indigenous people groups include the Aborigines and Torres Strait Islanders; a relatively wealthy country; religious freedom guaranteed by constitution.

What to Pray About: Growing increasingly secular and influenced by a New Age, self-created spirituality; increasing opposition toward Christianity. Need for Gospel witness to aborigine groups. Gospel witness – Cornerstone RBC (QLD); Hope RBC (QLD); Berean Bible Church (QLD); Samford Baptist Church (QLD); Providence RBC (WA); Covenant Baptist Church (WA); Emmanuel RBC (WA); Sovereign Grace Baptist Church (S. Aus); Hills Bible Church (Victoria); Cooma Reformed Bible Church (NSW); Smithfield Baptist Church (NSW); Southern District RBC (NSW); Newtown Baptist Church (NSW); Stanmore Baptist Church (NSW); Drummoyne Baptist Church (NSW); Warners Bay Baptist Reformed Church (NSW); Grace Evangelical Church (NSW); Bible College of South Australia.

Austria (EUROPE)

Population: 9,110,416

Languages: German, Turkish, Bosnian

Religions: Roman Catholic, Atheism, Protestant, Muslim

People: Famous for its culture; steady growth of materialistic, hedonistic lifestyle. Turks and Kurds are the largest single immigration group. Historic opposition against the Reformation.

What to Pray About: One of the highest rates of suicide in Europe; growing influence of alcoholism, drug addiction, and occultism. Heavy Catholic and New Age influence. Gospel witness – Grace Church (Vienna).
