Countries to Pray For:

Botswana (AFRICA)

Population: 2,480,244

Languages: English, Setswana

Religions: Anglicans, Methodist, United Congregational

People: One of the least populated countries in the world, second in AIDS prevalence. Wealthy economy based on diamond mining and safari tourism. Government is notably free of corruption; ranked as a middle-income country; high literacy rate.

What to Pray About: Large number of people infected with HIV/AIDS; many orphans. Christianity often combined with animism and old tribal rituals; pervasive nominalism. Gospel witness - Pastor Monametsi Bahudi of Central Baptist Church (Gaborone); Pastor Michael Legodi (Francistown).

Brazil (SOUTH AMERICA)

Population: 213,421,037

Languages: Portuguese

Religions: Roman Catholic

People: Comprised of three groups – Amerindians, Portuguese, and Africans. Natural resources have developed the economy into the largest in Latin America. Corruption in government and gap between the rich and the poor continues to be major problems.

What to Pray About: Poverty still affects millions, especially street children and indigenous peoples who suffer discrimination and exploitation. World's second-highest consumer of illicit drugs; world's highest rate of firearm homicides. Police are heavy-handed and corrupt; nation's prisons are overcrowded and violent. Many Brazilians practice Catholicism and Spiritism together. Gospel witness – Pastor Silas Roberto Nogueira of Reformed Faith Baptist Church (São Paulo); Pastor Daniel Teixeira of Comunidade Batista Novo Horizonte (Rio de Janeiro); church planter Danilo Moreti of RBC of Sao Joaquim da Barra (Sao Paulo); Pastor Renan Delefrate of RBC (Buritizal).
