Countries to Pray For:

Benin (AFRICA)

Population: 14,996,886

Languages: French; Fon and Dendi; Yoruba, tribal languages

Religions: Indigenous beliefs, Roman Catholic, Celestials, Muslim

People: One of the most politically stable countries in the region, though the government is corrupt; one of the poorest and least-developed African nations. Great religious freedom.

What to Pray About: Around 50,000 children trafficked to the neighboring nation of Nigeria each year; black market trading and smuggling also widespread. One of the least evangelized African nations; many “Christians” go to church on Sunday, then consult witch doctors during the week. Celestial Church of Christ cult was started in Benin (1947) with nearly half a million participants; similar practices to Mormonism, Judaism, and Pentecostalism, including radical acts of violence. Great need for Gospel witness.

Bhutan (ASIA)

Population: 727,145

Languages: Dzonkha, Tibetan and Nepali dialects

Religions: Kagyupa and Ningmapa Buddhist, Hindu

People: Remote, impoverished country between India and China; regular violent storms from the Himalayan mountains; country was off-limits to foreigners until 1974; number of tourists remains limited by government.

What to Pray About: Christians face much government opposition which seeks to isolate the country from the outside world, outlaws proselytism, and forbids existence of church buildings. Those who convert to Christianity do so at the loss of civil rights and benefits. Gospel witness – Indian husband and wife team, Raphan and Rebekah, missionaries to Bhutan with HeartCry.
