Countries to Pray For:

Brunei (ASIA)

Population: 452,524

Languages: Brunei Malay; English, Chinese (trade languages)

Religion: Islam, Buddhism, Roman Catholic, indigenous beliefs

People: Absolute monarchy and hereditary nobility. Wealthy nation because of oil and natural gas resources; one of two nations in the world with 0% national debt; depends heavily on agricultural imports.

What to Pray About: Freedom to practice other religions is guaranteed, though any non-Islamic material being distributed is subject to confiscation. In 2016, Sharia law was imposed on the country's Muslims, which take up roughly two thirds of the country's population, making Brunei the first and only country in East Asia to introduce it into its penal code. Great need for Gospel witness.

Bulgaria (EUROPE)

Population: 6,639,190

Languages: Bulgarian

Religion: Bulgarian Orthodox, Muslim

People: One of the oldest known birthplaces of civilization. Current stable economy and democracy. Claims Orthodoxy from early church near Macedonia.

What to Pray About: Constitution guarantees religious freedom, but designates Orthodoxy as "traditional" religion; Sunni Muslim is the second-largest religious community. Bulgaria has had negative population growth when the economic collapse (early 1990's) caused 937,000 to 1,200,000 people—mostly young adults—to leave the country by 2005. A third of all households consist of only one person; 75% of families do not have children under the age of 16. Birth rates are among the lowest in the world while death rates are among the highest. Evangelicalism has doubled in recent years through efforts of overseas missionaries. Gospel witness – Reformed Baptist Church (Borisova). Great need for Gospel witness.
