Countries to Pray For:

Burkina Faso (AFRICA)

Population: 23,667,262

Languages: French, native African languages

Religions: Sunni Muslim, Roman Catholic, indigenous native beliefs, Christian

<u>People:</u> Landlocked country vulnerable to drought; one of the poorest nations in the world due to political instability. Low literacy rate. Extreme poverty has led to massive migration of workers to Cote d'Ivoire for seasonal work, where the majority convert to Islam; the remainder is deeply involved in the occult, even the "Christian" groups.

What to Pray About: High mortality from HIV/AIDS, leading to infant mortality almost twice the nation's birthrate; ongoing child slavery and human trafficking. Missionaries often work in rural areas because of heavy Muslim influence in cities. Great need for Gospel witness and schools.

Burundi (AFRICA)

Population: 13,486,794

Languages: Kirundi, French, Swahili

Religions: Roman Catholic, indigenous native beliefs, Muslim

<u>People:</u> Densely populated; 90% subsistence farmers. 1962 independence triggered civil war between the Tutsi and Hutu majorities which led to genocides, assassinations, coups, and regional instability; country is now one of the world's poorest.

What to Pray About: Recent warfare (1993-2005) resulted in more than 250,000 deaths and 800,000 displaced. Refugees are now returning, but often lack basic services, are denied claims to their former land, and live in tent-cities. Country continues to suffer from poverty, corruption, weak infrastructure, poor access to health and education services, lack of access to education, and the proliferation of HIV/AIDS. Ongoing slavery and human trafficking. Great need for Gospel witness.
