- 23 The Korties (Native Amer., AZ) ask prayer for Sells Community Baptist Church (formerly First Papago Baptist) as they grieve the passing of Pastor Jay Juan’s dad, Paul. He was a pillar in the church and will be missed tremendously. Pray that his love for the Lord would continue to be a testimony to friends and family.
- 24 Baruch Maoz’s book, *God in His Beautiful Greatness*, is being edited in Hebrew and English. Pray for the Lord’s wisdom and blessing on these projects.
- 25 The church in Santiago, CHE, requests prayer for strength for their pastor, Obed Rupertus, and his wife. In addition to Obed’s own health struggles, recent demands on their physical and emotional resources have risen from their younger daughter and Maria Teresa’s mother.
- 26 Please continue to pray for the team of USAF Chaplain S., that their ministry would be effective and many would come to know the Lord.
- 27 From the Baldwins in Serbia: “Please pray that the Lord would raise up faithful men to lead the churches of Serbia. Up to half of the Baptist Churches in Serbia do not have a regular pastor. Very few men desire to go into ministry due to various societal reasons. Many who are in ministry do not value theological education or growing in maturity as pastors. God still has His faithful—who are humble, diligent, and sacrificial—and He is blessing their efforts. Pray that He be pleased to give them what they need.”
- 28 The Oliveiras thank God for Martin Bucer Seminary Portugal. They recently had their Intensive week of classes with 20 students. Please pray that the students will grow in knowledge and wisdom so that they may serve the churches in a God-pleasing way.
- 29 The Kilians ask that we pray for God’s provision and guidance in meeting ACU’s financial needs, trusting that He will supply the necessary resources to support the university’s mission and vision.

- 30 Olivier Favre asks us to pray for the church “La Maison de l’Evangile” in Mulhouse while everyone must adapt to their departure and find their place to engage in the service of one another.
- 31 JMW reports, “I just returned from a retreat for workers in a NA country and was encouraged by their stories of changed lives. Please support the work there with your prayers and finances. The work is hard! Pray for more workers.”

- 1 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) thanks God for the 20 wives, who were encouraged to holiness according to John 13-17 on March 9, and the 44 young people, who were stimulated in the faith on March 2-3. By the grace of God it's the result of your prayers. Please pray with him for a parallel training course for counsellors, camp leaders, and experts that is scheduled for April 1–6.
- 2 John Kortie (Native Amer. AZ) will be receiving radiation therapy until mid-April. He has experienced considerably more side effects from radiation than chemotherapy. Pray that God gives him stamina and opportunities to share his hope in Christ. Pastor Lee Miguel (Santan Baptist) will begin radiation soon for prostate cancer.  
Also, USAF Chaplain S. asks we pray for two of his teammates. Both of their fathers are in the end stages of their life. Pray that each of these men would know the Lord and would die in his peace.  
Lastly, Sam Masters (Argentina) had surgery March 20. Please pray for patience while recovering.
- 3 The Secrests ask prayer for the decisions that are being made by Iglesia Bíblica Gracia y Verdad in Lima as they continue negotiation with a local hotel for a new meeting place. This needs to be resolved by mid-April.  
Also, after searching for 10 months for new facilities, the church in the Aix-en-Provence region in the south of France has found and moved into a really excellent new rental place in the town of Gardanne. This is a communist town in which several evangelical groups have tried and failed to plant a church. The Vaughns ask that we pray for fruitful outreach in this new location.
- 4 Please pray for USAF Chaplain G. as he takes on the bulk of Protestant preaching responsibilities at the Chapel. Pray he will honor God in preaching the word faithfully and boldly.
- 5 Raul Torres (Juarez, MX) asks that we continue to pray, in accordance with Matthew 6:33–34, for the families in Ciudad, Juarez who are facing economic hardships due to job loss or reduced income.
- 6 Sam and Emma (formally S&E) working in South-east Asia ask that you continue lifting up their friends Lek and Leng who have shown interest in hearing the gospel. Sam and Emma also want to praise God that they passed their language evaluation and that they continue to see progress in understanding the culture and language.
- 7 Please pray for the salvation of the Emadi's (Rep. of Ireland) children.
- 8 Pr. Marcelo Brondo (Carlos Paz, ARG) has been preaching a series of messages on the Lord's death, burial, and resurrection. Pray that the Lord will use these, as the saints invite people from their own city and surrounding towns.  
Also, pray for the Selph's gospel outreach in Atlanta as they continue to make known the whole gospel in various settings to people who have only been exposed to parts of the gospel in their Christian heritage. Drug dealers, sex workers, alcoholics, etc. assume they are Christians.
- 9 The Masters (Argentina) report that the theme for the young adult retreat this year will be, "Don't waste your testimony". This annual retreat has been fruitful in the lives of the campers. Pray that this year will be as well and will clear up or solidify the critical paths for those that are searching.
- 10 The Ryttersgaards ask that we pray for the gospel seeds planted at the Good Friday service of CRBC Barbados.
- 11 Pray with the Secrests for the First Baptist Church in Chiclayo and for the fruit of a medical evangelistic campaign that was held March 21–29. This is an outreach of VASE (Voluntarios en Ayuda Social y Evangelismo).
- 12 Pray with the Kilians that God would raise up and bring to ACU faculty and staff who live out the Christian worldview in their teaching, mentoring, and interactions with students, modelling Christ-like character and wisdom.
- 13 Baruch Maoz is currently working through various views on hermeneutics for a book on the topic. Please ask the Lord for wisdom on his behalf.
- 14 Pray with the Oliveiras for the FIEL Conference (Portugal), which will be held on April 15–18. This conference has pastors and aspiring pastors as the primary audience. Last year, they had 220 in attendance (60 of those pastors).
- 15 Olivier Favre asks us to pray for the "Eglise Réformée Baptiste de la Broye" and its pastor, Stefan Zürcher. They are facing some difficult situations personally and in the church. Pray that Stefan will be refreshed in his service.
- 16 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) asks for prayers for the Rollock family's expected twin daughters in the coming weeks.  
Also, please pray for guidance for the health of Nancy Brondo (wife of Pr. Marcelo in Carlos Paz, ARG). Doctors are recommending prompt surgery as the only possible solution for the extreme pain in her knees due to osteoarthritis.
- 17 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) ask prayer that they would be able to find a house.
- 18 Pray for the Adopt-a-Pastor project led by David Vaughn and Olivier Favre which presently sends 4 Reformed books a year (for 7 years) to about 100 broadly evangelical pastors in France and Switzerland who are not Reformed. Pray that many would come to understand the biblical gospel in a new, life-changing way.
- 19 Please pray for USAF Chaplain G. to have continued favor with leadership and for his Chapel staff as they transition this summer.
- 20 Sam and Emma (SE Asia) ask that you pray for continued strength in language learning as they enter the final stage so they can clearly articulate the Gospel to their friends and neighbors.
- 21 Please pray with the Ryttersgaards for wisdom for the leadership of CRBC Barbados as they think through important matters.
- 22 Please pray for the Selphs' ministry in Atlanta. They need wisdom in dealing with the poor, desiring to help them and meet needs without creating a dependency and dulling an eagerness for personal responsibility.
