- 3 USAF Chaplain S. asks that we continue to pray this month for the Sanchez family and their son Zayden who is in leukemia treatment in Philadelphia. They are an Active duty Air Force family who are trusting the Lord for sustainment and healing during this ordeal.
- 4 Raul Torres (Juarez, MX) reports that they are preparing to baptize four individuals in July. Please pray that these individuals will continue to grow in their faith and persevere.
- 5 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) is looking forward to training some 40 young people July 6–13, laying important biblical and relational foundations with several Reformed Baptist pastors and others. Pray that it will be a profitable time.
