- 1 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) thanks God for the Ascension Day meeting for Swiss RB churches. The message preached encouraged believers to live for God according to His call, whether the call of salvation or the call of our personal vocation (job). Please pray for the RBC Neuchâtel children's Sunday school preparation meeting on June 3rd where Tim's successor will take the lead.
- 2 Please pray for the church plant led by David Vaughn in Aix-en-Provence, France. The church is looking for new facilities in which to meet. Pray that the Lord would provide just what they need. Pray also for the baptismal service on June 4 at which two young men, one of them a Muslim convert, will be baptized.
- 3 Please pray for David Vaughn as he gives 8 sessions of teaching on Biblical Piety today, as well as on June 10, to Christians from several churches in the great Brussels area (Belgium).
- 4 The Favres (France) ask prayer for Douglas and Bertha who will be baptized today. Pray that the Lord would encourage them as they face various challenges in their lives.
- 5 Please pray for the Selph's dear friend and key fellow-servant in Atlanta. Adina, who recently suffered two seizures just after she began an exciting new job as a medical assistant, is wrestling with trusting God. Her life has been very hard..
- 6 Baruch Maoz reports that he is continuing work on New Testament Bible notes, with the end now clearly in view. He requests prayer particularly as he nears work on the book of Revelation.
- 7 Pray that the Secrests (Peru) will be able to assist the 3 elders in the church in Miraflores. They are working full-time and are concerned about the needs of the church and their ability to meet those needs.
- 8 Please pray for health for Michael Emadi (Rep. of Ireland) as he has not been well recently..
- 9 Seven men completing their 4-year training at the RBC Bible College (Switzerland) will present their work tomorrow. Pray with the Wengers that this will be an encouraging moment for all churches.
- 10 The Favres (France) ask pray for the 8 students who will finish the training of le Collège Biblique today. Pray that they will be useful for Christ's church in serving with the gifts the Lord has given them.
- 11 The Torreses' (Juarez, MX) are praising God for allowing them to continue with the adoption process. Pray for their last interview to take place this month.
- 12 Please pray for the Oliveiras (Portugal) as they prepare for the Seminary's new academic year. Please pray for new applicants and all the logistical work they need to complete.
- 13 USAF Chaplain S. asks prayer for their Hurlburt Chapel staff as they go through summer moves. Pray for the Lord to guide and protect those who are going and coming.

- 20 The Oliveiras (Portugal) thank God for their Pastor's Conference held last month. The main speaker was Dr. Mark Dever. They had 230 in attendance, 60 of which were pastors. Please pray with them that the truths learned might be applied in the lives of the local churches.
- 21 Please pray for the Selph's inner-city Gospel work in Atlanta as they have increased the amount of time they are hanging out with people on the streets. Building relationships is key.
- 22 Pray with the Secrests for the preparations for the medical mission outreach to the mountains of Peru in the month of July. Larry will be returning on the July 10 to help lead the team of US doctors and Peruvian counselors, interpreters and dentists.
- 23 Michael Emadi has been put in contact with many Iranian refugees that have come to Belfast. Please pray as they try to figure out the best way to minister to them.
