- 1 The Secrests ask continued prayer for Iglesia Bíblica Gracia y Verdad in Miraflores, the district of Lima with the least number of evangelical churches. They have a strong leadership team but need to be in a new location by the end of the month.
- 2 Pray for the 3rd session of the "Discovering Christianity" evangelistic Bible study that David and Nicky Vaughn are holding tomorrow with several non-Christians.
- 3 The Favres (France) ask prayer for the Lausanne Bible College committee as they evaluate student applications for the next session and decide if there are enough students to begin the four-year program in the fall.
- 4 Please pray for the Selph's Gospel work in Atlanta, especially tomorrow, as they hold their first monthly worship service in the area they have been working for several years. This is not a church-plant effort, per se, but a next level of a preaching-point. It will be held at 4:00 p.m., followed by a dinner prepared by the people who live there.
- 5 The Masters report that there is a severe outbreak of Dengue in Argentina. Several families in the churches have been infected. Sam is about halfway through the expected recovery time. Please pray for his health and others affected.
- 6 Please pray for the John Kortie family (Native Amer., AZ). At the time of this writing, Bethanna has shared that, "Doctors told us today that John's journey in this life is almost over." Please pray for God's peace, comfort, and grace to be upon the Kortie family and that our gracious heavenly Father will continue to use John's legacy for his glory.
- 7 USAF Chaplain S. ask that we pray for Zayden, one of their homeschool teens who is battling leukemia. Pray that the chemo accomplishes its designed goals and he can receive a marrow transplant.
- 8 JMW asks prayer for the workload she deals with each day, for discernment in decisions, and for grace with people issues.
