MISSIONARY PRAYER GUIDE



*"For the earth will be filled with the
knowledge of the glory of the LORD
as the waters cover the sea"*

HABAKKUK 2:14

1 The Favres ask prayer for the afternoon Christmas gathering being held today at Payerne Reformed Baptist Church. Pray that many of those invited come to the meeting and be touched by the gospel that will be preached on this occasion.

Also, during December Pr. Obed Rupertus will be teaching the church in Santiago, CHE on membership with plans to implement a formal church membership beginning in 2025. Please pray for wisdom.

2 Please pray for USAF Chaplain S. as he works on an Air Force level, suicide prevention working group and is advocating for a faith-based response to suicide prevention. Pray that this gives opportunity to present the hope of the gospel.

3 Praise God for the safe delivery of a baby boy to Sam and Emma (SE Asia) despite some difficulties with the birth. Additionally, please pray for Sam as he is meeting with his local language helper and sharing with him the story of the gospel. Pray for L who is the language helper and appears to be very interested in knowing more about Christ.

Also, the Oliveiras ask prayer for the new members class at FBC Lisbon, Portugal, which includes two new believers.

4 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they plan to distribute Christmas gifts (helpful necessities) to street and poor people at this Christmas season along with the loving gospel of Jesus Christ.

5 Larry Secrest (retired from Peru) reports that on the 15th of September Bonnie fell and broke her left arm above the elbow. She had surgery on the 23rd of September and had a plate inserted with 15 screws. She is doing well and has PT 3 times a week. Please pray for her full recovery.

Also, the congregation in Carlos Paz, ARG (Pr. Marcelo Brondo) requests prayer for Claudia, a young wife and mother of 2, member of the church, who's just been diagnosed with cancer and must begin treatments.

6 Praise God that two families have recently moved to Cambodia to join DL in the effort to reach the C people with the gospel. Pray for them as they begin language learning and adjust to cross-cultural living.

7 JMW reports that the north region of Africa is progressing in the Gospel, however, they are seeing significant spiritual warfare. Please lift up the workers in this hard-packed land, that they would remember their calling, persevere, and be encouraged by seeing fruit for their labors.

8 The Emadi's (Rep. of Ireland) ask prayer for their housing situation. They have just been informed that their rent is increasing.

9 The Favres ask prayer for the decisions the summer camp organizers have to make this afternoon regarding the subjects and preachers who will teach at the next summer camp in France.

10 The Ryttersgaards ask that we pray for unity and solidarity among the membership of Covenant Reformed Baptist Church of Barbados as they vote on transitioning Jonathan Alleyne to the eldership of the church from his current role as deacon. Pending a successful vote, please pray for God's equipping and sustaining of Jonathan in his new role.

11 USAF Chaplain R. asks prayer for his ministry to a suicidal individual.

12 The Vaughns ask us to pray that the church plant near Aix-en-Provence, France, will see fruit from their efforts of evangelistic Bible studies and witnessing in the open air market in town. Pray also for the conversion of a handful of non-Christians now attending services.

13 The Kilians ask that we pray for ACU's leadership transitions in 2025. Pray for wisdom as new leaders step into key roles and also for God's guidance as mentors help develop these leaders to serve the students while staying true to the mission.

14 Please pray for the Selph's gospel labors in Atlanta. They have moved their monthly worship service to the third Sunday of each month for various reasons. This month it will be on the 15th. For this gospel service, they plan to comb the streets inviting lost people to preaching that will highlight the incarnation of the Son of God.

15 Pray with Raul Torres (Juarez, MX) that the men in their congregation would remain steadfast and grow in godliness.

Also, Raymond Graham (Jamaica) asks prayer that the Lord would supply funds to meet the ongoing monthly needs of the church.

16 Please pray for Baruch Maoz as he ministers to the churches and individuals in Israel who are traumatized.

Also, Alex Torres reports that as a result of the DANA storm there is a great opportunity to share the gospel in Spain. In Malaga and Valencia many families lost everything and are now looking for hope in churches. As a family they are well.

17 Pray for USAF Chaplain G. as he continues to take on the bulk of preaching responsibilities for Osan's Protestant Parish and also leads Bible studies. Pray for the Lord to use His Word.

18 Please continue to pray for USAF Chaplain S's adult children, Elisa and Caleb. They are both considering joining the local county sheriff's department cadet academy. This is a great opportunity for both of them. Pray that the Lord is with them through the process.

Also, the Oliveiras (Portugal) ask prayer for their middle son (David), who is applying for colleges in the USA, after the Portuguese government refused his high school diploma from the US.

19 Both Sam and Emma have completed their language studies and ask prayer for their family as they have moved from the capital city to their new home in the north of the country. Eventually, they will transition to the village about 3-4 hours from this town, but in the meantime they will be based in this town to assist with their business and learn the local dialect.

Also, the church in Santiago, CHE (Pr. Obed Rupertus) requests prayer for a church retreat planned for Dec. 21, where they hope to have baptisms.

20 The church in Miraflores, Peru (Iglesia Biblica Gracia y Verdad) is doing well and just celebrated their 4th anniversary. Pray with the Secrests for continued growth, peace in assembly, and the means to better support the pastors, Daniel and Martin.

Also, Raymond Graham of Grace Harbor Jamaica, which began in May of 2024, is seeing many come to the light of the gospel and asks that we pray that the Lord would raise up more potential elders to support the church.

21 DL praises God that teaching phonetics to missionary candidates at Radius International has gone very well. Pray for him as he prepares to teach phonology and grammar next year, that the students would be equipped well to proclaim the gospel to unreached language groups.

22 JMW's residency process is moving along, albeit slow; she is thankful to be moving ahead.

Also, Alex Torres asks prayer regarding the approval of his residency documents from the immigration office in Spain. They have been waiting since last June.
