22 Raul and Lidia Torres (Juarez, MX) report that a dear and long-time family from their church is moving away. They will be missed deeply. Pray that the Lord continues to strengthen the church and raise up more servants and leaders.

Also, please ask God to give Ben Layer wisdom as he trains future pastors for local churches in Poland.

23 Baruch Maoz is considering a ministry trip to Israel in 2026. Pray for the Lord's wisdom and guidance.

24 The Baldwins report, "We have a new student joining Akademia from Kosovo. This is a place where church planting is difficult due to the religious climate, and especially difficult because most pastors don't have enough money to support their family. Theological education is needed and desired by leaders there, but many are not able to even consider it due to cost, lack of book resources, and time. Pray that Akademia's accessibility builds the church in this theologically needy region."

25 The Wengers (Switzerland) give praise that Neuchatel's church has decided to be part of the constitutional GA for the French Reformed Baptist Network. Please pray for their youth group, which has been reduced by the departure of older members and young people who do not put faith first in their lives. Pray that the current leaders would be strengthened and motivated to seek out other young people by proclaiming the gospel and remaining deeply connected to the life of the church.

26 Pray with the Secrests for the work of VASE, a not-for-profit Peruvian agency which was established to promote the gospel using Peruvian medical professionals as well as support from the States.

27 Please pray with the Oliveiras for the First Baptist Church of Lisbon. Thank God for the growth and unity of the church. Pray for growth in maturity, characterized by a culture of discipling and growing in holiness.

28 Pray for David and Daniela Adams as they raise Kuyper (16 months). Pray for gospel opportunities through their marriage, in parenting, with their neighbors and other families in the community.

29 Sam and Emma (Southeast Asia) ask for prayer as they build relationships out among the language group they desire to see folks reached with the Truth. Along with that, they ask for wisdom as they look to, Father-willing, relocating to live out in the village in the coming months.

30 Please pray with the congregation in Carlos Paz, ARG (Marcelo Brondo) that the Lord will raise up leaders to assist in the work of the ministry there.

31 Please pray for the Selph's evangelistic work in west inner-city Atlanta as Bob and Cathi and two mature brothers are beginning to meet with individuals once a week in order to disciple them in more of the specifics of the gospel, centered in the book of Romans. This is an effort to build leaders for an eventual church plant.

## Missionary of the Month

Welcome to the November issue of RBNets *Missionary Prayer Guide* in which we are highlighting RBNets Missionaries, David and Daniela Adams. Along with prayer requests from other RBNets missionaries, each Sunday we are featuring specific requests from our missionary of the month (as highlighted in green). Thank you for your interest in all of our missionaries and for your prayer support of them.

- 1 The Grahams report that they are about to sign documents to complete the purchase of property to build the Grace Harbor Jamaica Church. Pray for provision of finances to begin building.  
Also, pray that God will be pleased to work by His Spirit among the Reformed Baptist Church in Santiago, Chile (Obed Rupertus). Pr. Jim & Nancy Adams will minister there during the first week of December.
- 2 Please pray for USAF Chaplain S. as he travels to Zambia early this month to teach hermeneutics to Zambian pastors and Chaplains.
- 3 Please pray for David Vaughn's health as he recovers from stent placement and a recent diagnosis of lymphocytic leukemia. Also pray that the Lord would raise up a godly and gifted young French man to take over as full time pastor of the church.  
Also, thank God along with Raul and Lidia Torres (Juarez, MX) that Lidia has just entered the second trimester of her pregnancy, and everything has gone well so far. Pray for God to continue to protect them both
- 4 Please pray for Mark and Cheryl in eastern Asia as they begin *Grace Marriage* with ten couples, an initiative to build healthy marriages around the power and grace of the gospel!
- 5 JMW requests prayer for her home assignment, which began on November 1; and for her mother, Evelyn, who turns 96 this month, is unsaved, and showing signs of deterioration.  
Also, continue to pray for ongoing medical issues that the Emadi family (Rep. of Ireland) faces.
- 6 The Favres ask prayer for themselves and for their son, Joel, and his wife, Anne, as they teach a day-long seminar on child rearing today in Lille (northern France).

- 7 Pray with David Adams that the Lord would use Poiema's gospel-centered books to bring reformation and an understanding of the Truth in a Spanish-language context saturated with false gospels.
- 8 Baruch Maoz is working at translating/rewriting his book on hermeneutics into Hebrew, the first ever in that language. Please pray for wisdom on this project.
- 9 Pr. Marcelo Brondo (Carlos Paz, ARG) requests prayer for their advent season services. Many unconverted are being invited personally and by radio and social media. Please pray that there'll be new fruit in saved souls.
- 10 Raymond Graham asks that we pray for the recovery of Jamaica after hurricane Melissa and that the Gospel of Jesus be preached for the salvation of God's people. Pray for faithfulness in the ministry work of Grace Harbor Jamaica.
- 11 The Wengers (Switzerland) ask prayer for a renewal of motivation to evangelize and welcome new people in Neuchâtel's Church. Pray that people would be moved by the amazing gospel of Christ for God's glory. Pray especially today (December 11) as they have a Bible stand on the street to give out gospel booklets and discuss Christ with the people. Also, on December 14, they will have a Christmas celebration to which they will be inviting folks in the church neighborhood. Pray for God to bless these efforts for His glory.
- 12 Pray for USAF Chaplain G. to have godly wisdom and spiritual strength as he navigates current responsibilities.
- 13 David Vaughn asks prayer for the Christmas evangelistic service at the church near Aix-en-Provence, France tomorrow (Dec. 14) and the church members who will be inviting non-Christian friends and distributing invitations at the open air market.  
Also, pray for the Emadi's (Rep. of Ireland) as they hold their Christmas outreach tomorrow.
- 14 Pray that the Lord would provide means for Poiema (David Adams) to begin publishing a trusted Reformed commentary series in Spanish. Pray that this series would help many pastors preach the Word faithfully.

- 15 Rejoice with USAF Chaplain S and family, and lift up their oldest son Caleb (20) who is starting a new career as a corrections officer for the state of Florida. He began his academy mid-November.
- 16 Please pray with the Layers that God would provide the finances for the congregation in Siedlce, Poland to purchase land and build a church building as a sort of beachhead for the spread of the gospel throughout this country.  
Also, as the new year approaches, the Favres ask that we pray especially for the Maison de l'Evangile church in Morschwiller-le-Bas in Alsace (France) as this year should, God willing, be the year of the construction of their new building. Pray that the Lord would provide for their needs
- 17 The Secrests ask prayer for Pastor Daniel Maxi and his church in Miraflores, a district of Lima, Perú. Pastor Daniel is in need of financial support and wisdom as he directs the ministry of Iglesia Biblica Gracia y Verdad.  
Also, please pray for Gilson Santos, an experienced Brazilian pastor who is willing to serve alongside Tiago Oliveira as a missionary in Portugal. Pray for wisdom as Gilson seeks to lead his church to seek another pastor. Pray that the Oliveiras can raise the necessary funds for him
- 18 Sam and Emma (Southeast Asia) ask that you join them in lifting up their family as they transition to another rental house in a different part of town.
- 19 Please pray for USAF Chaplain G. to be useful in God's hands with opportunities to preach and teach.
- 20 Please pray the Selph's evangelistic work in west inner-city Atlanta as they hold their monthly worship service on December 21 at 4:00 p.m. Lord willing, the Selphs are going to increase that worship service in January to two times a month (2nd and 4th Sundays) in an effort to eventually get to every Sunday.
- 21 A publisher in Spain recently joined Poiema (David Adams). Pray that the Lord would increase the reach of gospel-centered books in Spain, where there are many Muslim immigrants and less than 2% of the total population is Evangelical, and that the Lord would use this new partnership in Spain to call many to faith.
