HABAKKUK 2:14

- 21 Sam and Emma (SE Asia) ask that you lift up one of their employees who is forbidding his wife from attending a small local fellowship in town. Ask that God, our Father, would change his heart and that he would desire to learn of the Son together with his wife.
- 22 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) request prayer for Patrick and Dylan: two young men who may be getting baptized.
- 23 Pray with Mark and Cheryl (East Asia) for the provision for future elders there in a church with significant transitory membership.
- 24 Pray with the Wengers regarding the Cyfoje training program held July 27-31 for young people ages 16 and up. God often uses these courses to transform, strengthen, and guide participants in their faith. Also pray during this time for eternal fruit from the summer camps that the Reformed Baptist Churches hold.
- 25 The Masters ask prayer for the search for new property for the church in Cordoba, ARG.
- 26 Please pray for the Stoley's (USAF Chaplain) oldest daughters, Elisa and Katelyn, that the Lord will guide them to good jobs in Maryland and be pleased to bring godly young men into their lives who would be suitable husbands.
- 27 Please pray for the wives in the congregation in Santiago, CHE (Pr. Obed Rupertus)—that they'll recognize Christ's rule in their lives and wisely guide their children in the truth for their daily work.
- 28 Pray for wisdom for the Baldwins as they explore the expansion of the ministry of Akademia (E. Europe). The school offers things to non-western students that are unique and helpful, and they speak to many other non-western schools that are struggling. There are many ways that Akademia can expand the kingdom of Christ and build healthy churches. Our God is a God of the impossible. The Baldwins seek to know how He would want them to serve in these new circumstances.
- 29 Please pray for the Selph's ministry in west Atlanta as they host a Bible study every Tuesday evening. A growing group is coming to learn the gospel. Some are homeless, some are not. Some can read, some cannot. Some shows signs of grace, some do not.

- 30 The Oliveiras ask prayer for Pastor Gilson and Nadir Santos (Brazilian missionaries in Portugal). Pray for their adjustment to Lisbon and integration at the First Baptist Church of Lisbon. Also, pray for their financial support.
- 31 Pray with the Secrests for the medical team working with VASE in Lima, Peru. One of their goals is to establish a Peruvian network of doctors from area churches to work together to display mercy and share the gospel with those in need. Pray for the planning of next year's ministry and the means to support and promote this ministry.

## Missionary of the Month

Welcome to the July issue of RBNet's *Missionary Prayer Guide* in which we are highlighting RBNet Missionary, USAF Chaplain Josh Stoley. Along with prayer requests from other RBNet missionaries, each Sunday we are featuring specific requests from our missionary of the month (as highlighted in green). Thank you for your interest in all of our missionaries and for your prayer support of them.

- 1 Pray for David Adams and the Poiema team as they plan this year's "Muestra a Cristo" conference on the Psalms. Registration just opened. Pray that the Lord would bring many to hear expository preaching and participate in gospel-centered corporate worship.
- 2 Sam and Emma, working with the Niang people in SE Asia, ask prayer for strength and grace as they are hoping to move into the Niang village this summer, and their coworkers will be back in the States over that time.  
Also, the Gopalans ask for continued prayer to be fully funded and to be able to be in Peru by August 17. In addition, please pray that they will find a good tenant to rent their state-side home while in Peru, as well as an honest property manager so they can be worry-free regarding their home while in Peru.
- 3 Larry Secrest is ministering in Lima, Peru until July 14. Please pray for his preaching in these three churches: June 28th, Iglesia Bautista Mahanaim in Ventanilla (district of Lima); July 5, Iglesia Biblica Gracia Eterna in Barranco (district of Lima); and July 12th, Iglesia Bíblica Gracia y Verdad in Miraflores (district of Lima). Pray for fruit and journeying mercies in travel.
- 4 Please pray for Olivier Favre (France), who will be leading a teaching series July 4–11 on "one another" at a "Christian hotel" in the Swiss Alps. Pray that the Spirit of the Lord will work to show everyone the importance of caring for one another in the church.  
Also, Mark and Cheryl (East Asia) ask prayer for the men preaching through the book of Malachi during the summer.
- 5 USAF Chaplain Stoley asks prayer for his family's move. Pray that he would settle into his new position well and be a good steward of the responsibilities entrusted to him. Pray also, that the Lord would be pleased to give ample opportunities for gospel ministry.

- 6 Please pray for the five men Raul Torres (Juarez, MX) is meeting with regularly to disciple and equip them to be godly leaders in their homes and to grow in their theological training.
- 7 The Nehemiah Project in Poland is a program designed to provide a theological education and prepare men for local church ministry. Please pray with the Layers for the 23 men currently enrolled, that God will give them wisdom and courage to serve in His church.
- 8 Please continue to pray for the Emadi (Rep. of Ireland) family's continued health issues.  
Also, Pr. Marcelo Brondo (Carlos Paz, ARG) asks that we join them in interceding on behalf of Bilma Molina, widow of former pastor Jorge, whose cancer has returned, requiring a bone-marrow transplant.
- 9 Tim Wenger and the church of Neuchâtel are grateful for the decision to continue providing full pastoral support through 2027. The focus now is on ensuring the church's long-term sustainability. Pray with the church regarding sustainability, an ongoing disciplinary matter (that God will turn it into salvation and guide the elders to demonstrate love in truth with compassion), for the summer season when conversations with neighbors come more naturally, and that the gospel may spread.
- 10 Pray for the Selph's ministry in west Atlanta as they hold a worship service every other Lord's Day (2nd & 4th) at 4:00 p.m. Bob preaches the first one and a guest preacher proclaims Christ in the second. Pray for souls to be won to our Savior!
- 11 Praise God with the Masters (Cordoba, ARG) for Fabian Abregu's recovery after cancer treatment.  
Also, Raul and Lidia Torres (Juarez, MX) praise God and thank all who prayed for the safe arrival of their son, Caleb, who was born on May 15. Although it was a high-risk delivery, Lidia is recovering well and the baby is doing well also. To God be the glory!
- 12 Pray for USAF Chaplain Stoley's oldest son, Caleb, and his wife, Vianey, who are remaining in Florida. Caleb graduated from the Corrections Academy for the Florida Department of Corrections and will be serving as a Corrections Officer. Pray that the Lord use him as a witness to the inmates under his care.

- 13 Please pray for the leadership of the church in Santiago, CHE (Pr. Obed Rupertus)—that they will confront sin with mercy and truth, remaining faithful and firm.
- 14 Pray with David Adams for wisdom and the Lord's provision as the Poiema team works on publishing several Martyn Lloyd-Jones books in Spanish in this second half of the year.  
Also, Ben Layer (Siedlce, Poland) reports that in the weeks ahead, they will publish in Polish a daily devotional book, "Solid Joys." Please pray with them that this resource by John Piper will spread throughout all local churches in Poland, opening many eyes to the beauty of Jesus and the wonder of the doctrines of grace.
- 15 Pastor S (India) asks that we please pray for his family and for the ongoing work of the ministry. The work will be challenging going forward after the loss of his father-in-law who was a vital part of the ministry. Pray that the gospel will continue to spread from the opportunities the Lord provides.
- 16 Pray with the Oliveiras for the Martin Bucer Seminary (Portugal) as they plan for the new academic year. Pray for professors, students, and their churches.
- 17 The Baldwins are working to adjust back to living in the American culture from Serbia. Pray that the Lord will give emotional, spiritual, and physical grace and the ability to transition entirely for their good and the good of the ministry. They praise God that He gave a home to live in and a solid church to be a part of again.
- 18 Please pray with the congregation in Carlos Paz, ARG (Pr. Marcelo Brondo) for Matias Caminos, a newly-attending young man who has trusted Christ and is boldly telling his family and friends of Christ.
- 19 Pray for the Stoley (USAF Chaplain) family as they find and settle into a local church. Pray that they will make good Christian friends, grow in their faith, and that the Lord will be pleased to use them to serve the families in the church and the local community, especially fellow military members.
- 20 Please pray that the Lord will grant wisdom to Olivier and Denise Favre (France) as they provide spiritual care and support to Olivier's elderly parents (ages 97 and 91).
