- 24 JL (formerly JW) praises God for the successful relocation of her 96-year-old mother to her home in Florida for extended care. Pray for patience, grace, and for her mother’s salvation.
- 25 Pray for Mark and Cheryl’s (East Asia) discipleship/church planting efforts on a university campus in the west part of their city where they have a number of African students who are part of BBC.
- 26 Please pray for the Selphs in their efforts to win people to Christ in West Atlanta. They not only pursue people they have shared the gospel with in the past, but they are always looking for new people to share the gospel with.
- 27 Please pray with the Layers as the small congregation in Łuków, Poland, becomes independent from the Siedlce church and begins to function autonomously. Ask God to grant pastor Adam Urban wisdom as he leads the congregation in the days and years ahead.
Also, Raymond Graham (Grace Harbour Jamaica) asks prayer for men to be raised up as elders.
- 28 Pray for a still wider distribution of Baruch Maoz’s books in Israel for the promotion of a Biblical, Reformed understanding of the faith.
- 29 The Baldwins (Serbia) praise God for another crossed milestone. After almost 3 years of operation, the master’s program of Akademia graduated its first class. Four students participated in graduation in May. Thank the Lord with them, and pray that these students will use this gift to know God more deeply and lead others in a Christlike way.
- 30 Sam and Emma working in SE Asia ask that you join them in praying for relationships among the Niang as they build a house in the village where they hope to live and work long-term. They hope to move into their house this summer.

Missionary of the Month

Welcome to the June issue of RBNets' *Missionary Prayer Guide* in which we are highlighting RBNets Missionaries, Baruch and Bracha Maoz. Along with prayer requests from other RBNets missionaries, each Sunday we are featuring specific requests from our missionary of the month (as highlighted in green). Thank you for your interest in all of our missionaries and for your prayer support of them.

- 1 Please continue to pray for the Gopalans as they are currently in the fundraising phase, so they can go to Peru and minister there by the first week of August 2026. Their goal was to be fully funded for monthly support by the end May. With 4 weeks to go (at the time of writing) they were currently at 62%. Pray that the Lord will provide.
- 2 Sam and Emma ask for your prayers as they attending a country wide "worker" conference within their sending organization. Pray that this would be a sweet time of encouragement in the Lord and refreshment for all involved.
- 3 Raymond Graham (Grace Harbour Jamaica) asks prayer for finances and volunteers to refurbish their new church building.
Also, pray with the Olivieras for the fundraising needs for Pastor Gilson Santos (Brazilian Missionary at FBC Lisbon).
- 4 Pray with the Wengers (Switzerland) for the following Gospel sharing opportunities: the Bible stand (today and June 25) and the church's monthly Awana club for Ukranian youths and children (June 13), where several non-Christians are taught the Bible.
- 5 The Secrests ask prayer for the Iglesia Biblica Gracia y Verdad in in Miraflores, Peru. They received notice that the owner of their facility has received an offer from a potential buyer. They will need to find another location to accommodate 300 people or find the funding to purchase the building themselves. They might be able to secure a loan, but the down payment would be substantial as the building is valued at 1.5 million.
Also, pray with the Layers for God to provide the Siedlce, Poland congregation with needed facilities: a sanctuary to accommodate the congregation, a book warehouse, pastors' training rooms, and a recording studio. They've raised \$70,000 of the \$175,000 needed for the land. They have a way to go but are full of hope.
- 6 JL (formerly JW) reports she is on a hiatus to care for her mother and is seeking the Lord's guidance for an ongoing, part-time, distance role within the North Region office. Pray that she would hear God's voice and be obedient.
- 7 Baruch Maoz asks prayer for a successful editorial process on the English version of his book on hermeneutics.
- 8 The Baldwins (Serbia) report that the new Akademia course on Christian Leadership in the church begins this month. Problems with travel, due to the events in the world, have impacted whether the course will be taught in-person or only online. Pray that the professor will be able to work out the details to teach in the best way possible.
- 9 Please join Pr. Obed Rupertus and the congregation in Santiago, CHE, in prayer for growth in grace for the recently added members and the candidates for baptism.
Also, pray with the Emadis for Patrick and Dylan as they have been having conversations about getting baptized.
- 10 The Vaughns ask that we pray that the Lord would provide a godly and gifted young Frenchman to take over the pastorate of the church near Aix-en-Provence, France. (Matt.9.38).
- 11 USAF Chaplain S. asks prayer for a dear friend he has been counseling who has decided to leave their spouse due to grievous, unrepentant sin. Pray that the would Lord protect and strengthen his friend in their faith.
- 12 Pray with the Secrests regarding their medical mission outreach June 25–July 2. They are now receiving applications for team members and could use more doctors. Their emphasis is finding Peruvian medical professionals, but they can also receive physicians from the States. The purpose is to display mercy, share the gospel, and strengthen two churches in Ventanilla, a district of Lima.
- 13 Pray for the Selph's worship services on the second and fourth Sundays of each month in West Atlanta. They spend time on the streets inviting people to these gospel services.
- 14 Pray for grace, wisdom, and enabling for Baruch Maoz in the process of rewriting his book on hermeneutics into Hebrew and abbreviating the book on church life.
- 15 Pray with Mark and Cheryl (East Asia) for lasting fruit from their May 30th Parenting Workshop using Family Life's "Art of Parenting" with seven couples.
- 16 Tim Wenger reports that Neuchâtel's Reformed Baptist Church (Switzerland) has several decisions to make this month: a discipline case, a constitution change (new membership status for sent missionaries), lastly the changes to Tim's financial support starting in January 2027. Please pray regarding these matters.
- 17 Pray for the Gopalans as they try to tidy things in their home and find a tenant to rent their property before leaving for Peru. Pray that they will find a suitable tenant.
- 18 Join Cornerstone Church, Mesa, AZ, Pr. Marcelo Brondo, and the congregation in Carlos Paz, ARG in rejoicing for the May 9 celebration of the church's 18th anniversary. Pray that God will give wisdom to Pr. Brondo, to find a larger meeting place for the church.
- 19 The church in Santiago, CHE (Pr. Obed Rupertus) is grateful that its members have had opportunity to travel and give direct witness to family members. Pray for God's redeeming work in their lives.
- 20 Please keep USAF Chaplain S. and family in prayer as they move from Florida to Maryland for an assignment at the Pentagon.
Also, pray as Michael Emadi (Rep. of Ireland) is trying to build a cross-border relationship with another church.
- 21 Pray for Baruch Maoz's October–November ministry trip to Israel. An earlier trip was cancelled due to the war in the Middle East.
- 22 The Vaughn's ask for prayer for several unconverted people who have recently been attending the Church near Aix-en-Provence, France. Please pray that the Lord would give saving faith and repentance. One man in particular, 89 years old, has indicated that he is under deep conviction of sin.
- 23 The Oliveiras ask prayer for Gilson Santos (Brazilian Missionary at FBC Lisbon). Pray for his transition to Lisbon and for the approval of his legal status.
