- 27 The Secrets have been working with a local Hispanic church plant in Greenville, SC. The church is led by Claudio Molina, the son-in-law of Don Donell. This group has now combined with another Hispanic church plant in Greenville, SC, working out of Christ Fellowship Church in Cherrydale. This is a good group with potential leaders. Pray that it might grow and prosper.
- 28 Praise the Lord with USAF Chaplain G. The gospel is being shared with many individuals at Osan Airforce Base, both in counseling sessions across the base, and off-base. Many opportunities are with those who have left the church. Please pray for the Lord to draw people to Himself.
- 29 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) and Olivier Favre (France) ask prayer for the gathering of Reformed Baptist churches in Switzerland today (Ascension Day). Olivier will bring a message on "Living in this World with a View to Heaven". Pray that the Lord will bless the fellowship of believers for His glory on this day and motivate them to spread the gospel together.

Welcome to the May issue of RBNets' *Missionary Prayer Guide* in which we are highlighting RBNet Missionaries, Bob and Cathi Selph. Along with prayer requests from other RBNet missionaries, each Sunday we are featuring specific requests from our missionary of the month (as highlighted in green). Thank you for your interest in all of our missionaries and for your prayer support of them.

- 1 Pray for fruit from David Adams's meetings with bookstores and distributors from many Spanish speaking countries May 1–2. Pray for the advancement of gospel-centered books in the Spanish-speaking world.
- 2 Please pray for a team from David Vaughn's church near Aix-en-Provence, France, who will be at the local open-air market giving out evangelistic literature and sharing the gospel with those present at the market on May 4.
Also, pray for David and Nicky Vaughn as they host and work with a young couple from the Brussels Bible Institute who will be with them for a short internship the first two weeks of May.
- 3 Please pray with the Favres for the La Maison de l'Evangile church in Mulhouse where Olivier will be preaching tomorrow. This church is still in the process of raising funds for the construction of its new building.
- 4 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they conduct a Tuesday night Bible study, which has been going on for the last 3 years. There are 10–15 people attending each week who live in the area where Bob and Cathi live. Presently, the studies being taught are expositions of the parables of our Lord.
- 5 Pray with USAF Chaplain S. for the Hurlburt Field Chapel that the Lord would protect His flock and send fearless Christ-honoring chaplains to shepherd the flock on base.
- 6 Tim Wenger (Switzerland) asks prayer for the summer camps and training preparations. Counselors are needed for the children's camp. Tim also asks prayer for several young people in Neuchatel's church who are discontented with the church and need the transformation from the Holy Spirit. Pray that the LORD would give wisdom, love, consideration, and courage to those who take care of them.

- 7 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) ask that we pray for their health. They have had a lot of medical issues recently.
Also, the church in Santiago, CHE, sends thanks for prayers for their pastor—Obed Rupertus—and his mother who were recently injured in a car accident. God has granted healing to both of them. Pray for José in that congregation. He needs a kidney transplant due to an autoimmune disease.

- 9 Pray for the group of Spanish-speaking pastors that David Adams will help lead through a ten-day training on the biblical model for the church. Pray that they will return to their home countries encouraged and eager to shepherd their churches well.
- 10 Raúl and Lidia Torres (Juarez, MX) thank God for recent visitors. Pray that Raúl will wisely get to know them and care for their souls.
- 11 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they conduct Saturday morning gospel Bible studies at City of Refuge Women's facility (main campus) and also Wednesday night Bible studies at the City of Refuge Men's facility. The women are being rescued from life-altering problems and are looking for a new start on life. - 16 Praise the Lord, people are continuing to grow in their faith, and individuals are coming to faith at Osan Airforce Base. Please pray with USAF Chaplain G. for the Lord to continue to bless the preaching and teaching of His Word.
- 17 The Secrests ask that we pray that the Iglesia Biblica Gracia y Verdad in Lima, Peru, might soon find a new place to meet. Their attendance is now averaging over 250 per Sunday. The two elders are Daniel Maxi and Martin Manchego.
- 18 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they conduct gospel outreach through street evangelism in Atlanta's worst areas.
- 19 Please pray for wisdom for Pr. Obed Rupertus as he leads the congregation in Santiago, Chile, through the process of constituting as a church and developing a formal membership.
- 20 Please be in prayer for the many outreach events the Emadis have planned in the Republic of Ireland.
- 21 USAF Chaplain S. asks us to join with their family in praising God that their oldest, Elsie, was selected to join the local sheriff academy. Pray that the Lord will strengthen her to the task ahead as she prepares for this next chapter.
- 22 Please pray for the ministry in Lisbon, Portugal. For the last three years, the Oliveiras have sought a missionary to serve alongside them at FBC, Lisbon, and Martin Bucer Seminary Portugal. In God's providence, Tiago Oliveira believes they have found this man. Please pray that they can raise the necessary funds so that he can start serving in Portugal in 2026.
- 23 Raúl and Lidia Torres (Juarez, MX) ask prayer for the youth in their church. Pray that they will grow in maturity and in the knowledge of the Lord, be kept from the world and sin, and live lives that honor Him.
- 24 The Petersons (Costa Rica) ask prayer for the remaining financial provision needed (80% has been met).
- 25 Please pray for the Selphs in Atlanta as they conduct a Sunday afternoon worship service on the 4th Sunday each month to preach the gospel and to lead people in a worship service according to the Scriptures. These are people who would come from the various Bibles studies and street evangelism.
