- 21 Sam and Emma ask for prayer regarding building relationships and favor among the minority language group they are seeking to see reached.
- 22 Please pray for the Selph's evangelism efforts in west Atlanta. Their November Sunday worship service is planned for tomorrow (Nov. 23). They are also working toward starting a second monthly Sunday service at some point. Please pray for God's wisdom in doing that and for the Holy Spirit's blessings on the gospel.
- 23 Pray with Ben Layer as he plans to launch the "Nehemiah Project" in January 2026. This will be a two-year foundational theological education to prepare men to serve in their local churches. Ask God to raise up faithful men to boldly and faithfully proclaim the good news in Poland.
- 24 Pray that the medical mission outreach to Cusco and Quillabama would have been an encouragement to the churches and supplied a clear understanding of the gospel to those in attendance. Pray also for Larry Secrest's preaching ministry in two churches in Lima at the end of this month.
- 25 USAF Chaplain S. asks prayer for the Chaplain Corps. Pray the Lord would protect His shepherds and that they would be bold in the faith.
Also, please pray for USAF Chaplain G. to have opportunities to share the gospel with military members and in the community.
- 26 JMW started a 6-month home assignment on November 1st. Please pray for wisdom in balancing the need to continue working in a limited capacity with the need for personal rest and restoration and investment in family and a personal relationship.
- 27 Please pray with the Favres for the General Assembly of the Reformed Baptist Church of La Broye, which is taking place the evening of the 28th, and at which the church will decide whether to become one of the founding churches of the Network of French-speaking Reformed Baptist Churches.
Also, pray with the Grahams for the raising up of elders and deacons at Grace Harbour Jamaica.
- 28 Please ask for guidance as Pr. Obed Rupertus (Santiago, CHE) seeks to replace the ministry car totaled earlier this year in the serious accident in which God spared his life.

- 29 Pray for wisdom for David Adams and the team planning Poima's publishing schedule for 2026.
- 30 Pray with Ben Layer that the small church plant in the city of Łuków, which currently has 10 members, would grow. Pray that God will draw sinners to Himself and build His church in Łuków.

Missionary of the Month

Welcome to the November issue of RBNet's *Missionary Prayer Guide* in which we are highlighting RBNet Missionaries, Ben and Sarah Layer. Along with prayer requests from other RBNet missionaries, each Sunday we are featuring specific requests from our missionary of the month (as highlighted in green). Thank you for your interest in all of our missionaries and for your prayer support of them.

- 1 Please pray for David Vaughn's physical recovery after receiving a stent for a blocked coronary artery in October.
Also, pray for Pastor S. and his family's health and the ongoing work of the ministry. Your prayers are a vital part of their journey.
- 2 Pray with Ben Layer that their Polish publishing ministry, Gospel at the Center, would be used by God to spread the glorious Doctrines of God's Grace to tens of thousands of Polish people.
- 3 Please continue to pray for the Petersons as they settle and acclimate in Liberia, Costa Rica. Pray for the arrival of their items, which have been delayed in customs.
Also, Sam and Emma ask that you pray for their housing situation as they return to Southeast Asia. On their return they need to find a new place to live and relocate temporarily as they prepare to move to the language group in which they are working
- 4 Pray for Dwayne Baldwin as he will be speaking at a conference this month on "A Biblical Theology of Disabilities". This is for a group called "Hana's Hope," which works with Joni and Friends Ministries and provides Christian refuge and support for those with disabilities in Serbia. This is almost non-existent in Serbia and perhaps even the Balkans
Also, Marcelo Brondo, national pastor in Carlos Paz, ARG, asks that we join them in prayer as the gospel is proclaimed this month at a large baby shower where many unconverted friends and family are expected.
- 5 Please pray for the Selph's evangelism efforts in west Atlanta. The Tuesday night Bible study has been increasing in ongoing attenders showing a steady interest in the Word of God. This is where the Selphs are teaching more intensely about the desire to plant a church someday, if the Lord wills. Pray for souls to be won!

- 6 Please pray for the evangelistic conference on "Can God exist in a world of such evil and suffering" to be given by David Vaughn at the church near Aix-en-Provence on tomorrow evening, Nov.7.
Also, pray for Olivier Favre tomorrow (Nov. 7) and on Nov. 28 when he will be teaching two courses at the Brussels Bible Institute to prepare students for the challenges and trials they will face in ministry. Pray that this course helps equip these students for ministry.
- 7 Please pray for the Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) as they have an opportunity to start a few Bible studies at individual's homes. Most attending would be unbelievers.
- 8 Several of the marriages in the church in Santiago, CHE (Obed Rupertus) are in crisis. Please ask that the Holy Spirit would work powerfully to transform hearts so that Christ may be seen in those marriages.
Also, M & C ask prayer for their Grace Marriage initiative to be fruitful with the married couples in the body. Many are cross-cultural marriages with young children.
- 9 Please pray with Ben Layer for the 17 pastors currently enrolled in their expository preaching cohort. Pray that these workshops will grow and multiply and that expository preaching would become the regular practice of evangelical churches in Poland.
- 10 The Secrests ask that we pray for Daniel Maxi in Peru as Daniel recently wrote, "The situation in Peru is becoming increasingly complex in terms of security, extortion, and crime. Since I returned, two public transportation drivers have already been murdered in the Northern and Southern Cones. Today, there's a transportation strike. Miraflores isn't affected much, but Villa María is being impacted, and my wife and I go to the church plant there twice a week."
- 11 Raymon Graham asks we pray for a speedy process as the lawyers complete their documentation for the turning over of the land to Grace Harbour Jamaica. Pray also that they will have wisdom as they draw a plan for the church.
- 12 Please pray for David Adams and the Poiema team as they provide resources at a pastor's conference in Bogotá, Colombia with 220 pastors in attendance.

- 13 Please pray for USAF Chaplain G. to have wisdom navigating his new position in a way to foster faithfulness and boldness for Bible-believing chaplains.
- 14 JMW reports that her 11-day trip into one of the most difficult north African countries was full of blessings. There is genuine fruit among the most resilient people group. Workers are returning after leaving in fear several years ago. There are many who are presenting interest in serving here. Please pray for continued growth there.
Also, pray for fruit from M & C's recent exploratory trip to Busan, Korea to explore the possibility of a church plant with Jay and his wife Ji-Yoon.
- 15 Luke Peterson (Liberia, Costa Rica) asks prayer for the upcoming series on Titus that he is starting.
- 16 Please pray with the Layer family as the church plant in Siedlce has outgrown its meeting place. They now need to purchase land and build a permanent home for the local church and publishing ministries.
- 17 Tomorrow (Nov. 18) the association of churches in Argentina is holding a men's retreat where, among other things, they'll be asking the Lord to guide in the strengthening and growth of the church in Carlos Paz (Marcelo Brondo) as the good news is broadcast via radio throughout the region. Please uphold this time in prayer.
- 18 USAF Chaplain S. asks prayer as he has been carrying a heavy counseling load. Pray that the Lord will be pleased to use his efforts to speak gospel light into dark situations.
- 19 Pastor S. continues to preach the gospel faithfully, and the Lord is drawing many people to hear the Word. Pray for perseverance, boldness, and spiritual maturity among the growing body of believers.
Also, praise God with the Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) that an Irish woman named Rachel was recently baptized.
- 20 The Baldwins (Serbia) report that another potential student from Kosovo is interested in joining the Akademia program. This would be very strategic, as Kosovo is a needy and struggling area. Pray that the Lord raises up men from Kosovo who would lead that area in biblical truth.
