

25 Pray for wisdom for Baruch Maoz, currently in chapter 11 out of 15 of the first stage of rewriting into Hebrew the book of hermeneutics. The lack of theological terminology is challenging.

26 The Secrests ask prayer for the work of VASE (Voluntarios en Ayuda Social y Evangelismo) in Perú. Pray for wisdom in the planning of one- or two-day medical campaigns in areas of need around Lima. Also, pray for the funds needed to purchase the essential medical supplies.

Also, pray for David Adams and the Poiema team in their final days of preparation for the “Muestra a Cristo” conference on the Psalms in October. Pray that God would be glorified and many people would be served.

27 AW & JP (North Africa) ask prayer for their first annual pastors network retreat in October as pastors from across their country and surrounding countries gather to encourage and strengthen one another in Christ.

28 Please pray for the Selphs’ work in west Atlanta as they hold Bible studies and worship services to win precious people to Christ Jesus.

29 Please pray with Raul Torres (Juarez, MX) for the men in their church to faithfully lead their homes biblically and with integrity.

30 Please pray with the Favres that Tim Wenger’s three-month (October, November, and December) sabbatical in Neuchâtel will be a time of refreshing blessings for Tim and Marlyse, and that the Lord will sustain Olivier Favre (and Denise), who will be replacing Tim in Neuchâtel during this time.

Missionary of the Month

Welcome to the September issue of RBNets' *Missionary Prayer Guide* in which we are highlighting RBNet Missionaries, AW & JP (North African Partnership). Along with prayer requests from other RBNet missionaries, each Sunday we are featuring specific requests from our missionary of the month (as highlighted in green). Thank you for your interest in all of our missionaries and for your prayer support of them.

- 1 The Oliveiras ask prayer for Pastor Gilson Santos and his wife. Pray for their adjustment to life in Lisbon, their legal status in Portugal, and for fundraising (they are still short in their monthly needs).

Also, pray with the Layers that their application for Polish citizenship will be granted in less than a year, which will greatly help their future plans for life and ministry.

- 2 Pray for wisdom and resourcefulness for David Adams and the Poiema team as they plan the distribution of a kit of 7 books and a Study Bible to thousands of needy pastors in Latin America.
- 3 Pray for encouragement and fellowship for Sam and Emma (SE Asia) as their coworkers are back in the States for the summer.

Also, pray regarding the Gopalans' recent move to Pucallpa, Peru. Pray that their transition would be smooth, especially for their children being in a new environment and school.

- 4 Alongside leading Akademia, the Baldwins are providing assistance for worldwide theological schools in Latin America and Africa attempting to grow their schools, improve their structure, and partner with Grace Seminary. With the diversity of these schools, the Baldwins need prayer to be able to advise them in ways that would advance the gospel and healthy churches in their context.
- 5 USAF Chaplain S. asks prayer for a retired Master Sergeant struggling with cancer and the 15-year-old son of a Chief who has very aggressive cancer. Pray that the Lord would be pleased to heal both.
Also, please continue to pray for health for the Emadi family (Rep. of Ireland).

- 6 AW & JP (North Africa) ask prayer for the brothers and sisters in their church suffering through sickness, persecution, grief, homelessness, and instability.

- 7 Raul and Lidia Torres (Juarez, MX) ask that we pray that—in God's perfect timing,—Sarah's adoption process will move forward smoothly and be completed without further delays.

- 8 Mark and Cheryl (East Asia) ask prayer for their fall retreat September 11–13 with Dr. Geoffrey Thomas from London, England, on "The Greatness of Christ."

Also, pray for Baruch Maoz as he prepares for an October-November ministry trip to Israel. His weekends are booked and mid-week seminars are being booked.

- 9 Pray with the Secrests for the church planting effort of Iglesia Bíblica Gracia y Verdad in the district of Villa Maria del Tiumfo on the southside of Lima. Pastor Daniel Maxi is directing this effort and will attend the RBNet GA this month.
- 10 Pray for Tim Wenger to have the strength he needs as he speaks at a church in Paris September 18–20, at RBNet's General Assembly Sept. 22, and then travel to a Reformed Baptist church in Canada.
- 11 Pray for David Adams and the Poiema team in their final days of preparation for the "Muestra a Cristo" conference on the Psalms in October. Pray that God would be glorified and many people would be served.
- 12 Pr. Marcelo Brondo and the congregation of Light on a Hill in Carlos Paz, ARG, ask that we praise God with them for their growing unity and love for each other and for the faithfulness of the preaching of the gospel there. While they continue to need a larger meeting place, God is bringing together a group in a nearby town that may be a future church plant.
- 13 AW & JP (North Africa) ask us to pray that God would give the unbelievers visiting their church eyes to see their sin, ears to hear the gospel, and hearts made alive to believe in Christ.

- 14 Please for the Selph's gospel labors in west Atlanta as they seek to discern where each person is spiritually. A person's profession—and there are many professing Christ there—does not necessarily mean a possession of saving grace.

- 15 The Oliveiras ask prayer for Martin Bucer Seminary (Portugal) and the beginning of the academic year. Pray for students and professors alike. Pray for their churches. Pray that what is taught and learned might be applied faithfully, diligently, and wisely.

- 16 The Wengers give thanks for the Cyfoje training sessions in Switzerland held in early July, the summer camp in late July, and the children's camps in early August, where God worked through His grace, touched hearts, and kept all safe.

- 17 The Favres and Wengers ask prayer for the first in-person General Assembly of the Francophone Reformed Baptist Network, which will be held at the Reformed Baptist Church of La Broye (Payerne, Switzerland) today through the 19th. Ask the Lord to grant His wisdom in all the decisions they make, and that there will be a spirit of fellowship.

- 18 Praise God with the Layers in Poland that, in less than one year, He has provided \$175,000 for phase one of their building project! This money will be used to purchase the land on which they will build. May His Kingdom in Poland increase!

- 19 USAF Chaplain S. asks prayer for the Air Force Chaplain Corps. The Secretary of War has issued directives calling chaplains back to their pastoral identity. Pray that they seize this opportunity!

- 20 Pray with AW & JP (North Africa) for their three upcoming pastoral interns: two coming from another church in their city, and one from their own membership who may become a candidate for eldership alongside AW.

- 21 Sam and Emma, working with the Niang people in SE Asia, request that you join them in asking the Father for strength and grace as they're living out in the Niang village, beginning to invest in relationships, and starting to learn the Niang language while also finishing building their house.

- 22 The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) ask prayer for Patrick and Dylan who were scheduled to be baptized at the end of August.

- 23 Mark and Cheryl (East Asia) ask prayer for their fall initiatives: Art of Parenting, new members' class, and officer training for prospective elders and deacons.

- 24 Please pray that the Lord would strengthen Pastor SB (India) and His other servants, protect their families, open doors for the gospel, provide for every need, and bring many to repentance and faith in Jesus Christ.
